Spirit Candles *(Make sure the deacon is notified when to dim the lights).*

Vanessa: For the light of our program we turn to the Spirit of Adventuring. The Candle which has just been lit represents this spirit. It is the spirit of busily working and shining for Jesus, building bodies and mind and helping others. Above all, it is a Spirit of Reverence, training for service to God and man.

Marsherene: For the light of our program we turn to the “Spirit of Pathfindering”. The candle that I now light represents this spirit. It is the spirit of adventure, fun, learning, camaraderie, awareness and awakening. And about all, a Spirit of Reverence, and the Spirit of Service to GOD and man.

Foundation Candles *(Call the names of the staff that will light the six foundation candles while giving the appropriate meaning for the level represented by the candles lit.)*

Vanessa: This Spirit of Adventuring candle that I previously lit is not complete or sufficient by itself. However, to introduce the complimentary lights, we call on our Adventurer Staff.

Little Lamb *(Light the white candle)*

Ashlene: The Little Lamb is a course of study in learning to obey Jesus.

Eager *(Light the brown candle)*

Althea: The Eager Beaver is a course of study in learning how to eagerly working for Jesus.

Busy Bee *(Light the Light Blue Candle)*

Dalene: The Busy Bee is a course of study in learning how to be busy working for Jesus.

Sunbeam (*Light the Orange Candle*)

Judith: The Sunbeam is a course of study in learning how to be courteous Sunbeams shining for Jesus every day.

Builder (*Light the Dark Blue Candle*)

Soriah: The Builder is a course of study in learning how to build Christian Character and strong bodies for Jesus.

Helping Hands (*Light the Maroon Candle*)

Vanessa: The Helping Hand is a course of study in learning how to lend a helping hand in serving Jesus at home, school, and in the community.
