The Uniform

The uniform helps make the Pathfinder, Adventurer, and Master Guide Ministry tangibly visible. It is emblematic and representative of the worldwide ideals and standards of the organization and of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. Each individual member becomes a very vital representative of the organization and wearing the uniform will help to provide a consciousness of belonging to a club that rightly represents the Adventist Youth of today. If the uniform is worn as ordinary clothing, it will have failed in its purpose. The uniform should always be neat and clean. To wear it commonly for ordinary play or work lowers its dignity. The Club should be so valuable to each member that the uniform will be acquired and worn with enthusiasm.

It is recommended that uniforms be worn on the following occasions:

- 1. At all Pathfinder & Adventurer meetings (A or B as directed)
- 2. At any public gathering when any or all act as:
 - Messengers
 - ♦ Ushers
 - Guards of honor
 - Color Guards
- 3. On occasions as specified by the local director, leadership team or Conference officials.
- 4. At special services of the ministry (Adventurer Day, Pathfinder Day, Master Guide Awareness Day, Induction, Investiture, etc.)
- 5. While engaging in witnessing activity, or community service such as ingathering, distributing food baskets, flowers, literature, etc.

Uniforms should not be worn:

- ♦ By nonmembers
- When engaged in selling or solicitation for personal profit, or for commercial or political purposes
- ♦ At any time or place when its wearing discounts the organization or casts any reflection upon the uniform, lowers its dignity and esteem, and makes it commonplace.

NORTHEASTERN CONFERENCE UNIFORM STANDARDS and SPECIFICATIONS



ADVENTURER MINISTRY

Adventurer Class "A" Full Dress Uniform

- ♦ Light blue shirt for boys
- ♦ Light blue blouse for girls, blouse should have a Peter Pan collar with no decoration or extra stitching
- A navy blue long sleeve t-shirt may be worn under the Class A shirt in cooler weather.
- White uniform shirt with epaulets and patches for all staff. Shirt sleeve length should be uniform within the club.
- Adventurer Neckerchief: The Adventurer neckerchief is to be worn by all inducted Adventurers and Non-Master Guide Staff. It is burgundy in color bordered in white with the Adventurer emblem as the logo on the back. The scarf is worn fitted neatly around the neck held together in front with the cloth slide having the Adventurer logo affixed and properly positioned.
- ♦ Uniform Sleeves:
- ♦ Right: 1/2in from seam/shoulder place club name crest, 1/2in below crest place Rank Strip (Staff), 1/2in below Rank Strip (or 1/2in below crest if not staff) place Adventurer patch.
- ♦ Left: 1/2in from seam/shoulder place Conference patch, place Union Patch 1/4in below Conference patch, place Adventurer World Patch 1/4in below Union patch, where applicable place Master Guide Star 1/4in below World patch.
- Men and boys are authorized to wear a navy blue tie.
- ♦ White gloves
- Only staff should have name tags
- Honor sash (if you have at least one Award's patch or were invested in any class): The sash is navy blue. It is worn from the right shoulder to the left hip. Adventurer stars, chips, awards, pins, event patches, and other club related items may be displayed on the sash. Little Lamb stars and Eager Beaver chips are placed on the back of the sash as well as any event patches (i.e. Camporee patch, Fun Day patch, BAYDA Fun Escape patch, etc.). On the front of the sash place patches of the awards for Busy Bee through Helping Hands as well as the class pins received at Investiture.
- Navy blue Adventurer belt with the correct Adventurer buckle or regular dress belt holding pants/skirt neatly at the waist
- ♦ Navy blue uniform pants for males or navy blue A-line skirt for female staff. Female children wear the navy blue V-neck style jumper. There must be no decoration or extra stitching on pants, skirt or jumper. Skirt or pants may have no more than three pleats on each side on the front.
- Navy blue plain socks for male staff and Adventurers, navy blue ultra sheer stockings for female staff; Female children may alternate between navy blue tights during the winter and socks in the warm weather. All the kids in the club have to wear one or the other, maintaining uniformity at any given time. There must be no decorations on the socks.
- ♦ Shoes: black, laced up, leather or low rubber soled Oxford style shoes with no decoration or extra stitching; no patent leather/glossy shoes
- ♦ Adventurer women and girls are authorized to wear the navy blue beret with the small Adventurer logo. The beret must be worn with the logo directly centered and over the nose. The excess material is draped over to the right ear, extending to at least the top of the ear, and no


- lower than the middle of the ear. When worn properly, the beret is formed to the shape of the head. The beret is to be worn horizontally one inch above the eyebrow.
- ♦ Jewelry should NOT be worn with the exception of a watch, engagement and wedding rings or medical identification chains.



Adventurer Class "B" Field Uniform

- ♦ Whenever Class A uniform is not required, Class B uniform must be worn on all Adventurer approved and sponsored activities or events. Each club must agree to a class B field uniform standard which must be adhered to by all staff and club members. The club T-shirt must have the Adventurer logo prominently imprinted and displayed somewhere on it. Where instructed, at Area or Conference events, the area or Conference T-shirt may be substituted for the club T-shirt. Officers and Staff Members are permitted the use of a Staff polo style shirt with the appropriate Conference or Area club designs.
- In addition to the shirt, the field uniform will consist of the blue jeans, white tube socks and sneakers.
- Males will wear the shirts of the Field Uniform tucked into their jeans at all times. Jeans are not to be worn baggy or hanging below the waist.
- Females may wear the shirts of the Field Uniform out of their jeans/pants covering their middles at all times.
- Female and male jeans also should not conform to the shape of the body, i.e. skinny jeans or jean leggings. In addition, jeans should cover the ankles.
- ♦ Jewelry should NOT be worn with the exception of a watch, engagement and wedding rings or medical identification chains



PATHFINDER MINISTRY

Pathfinder Class "A" Full Dress Uniform

- Tan uniform shirt with patches, pleated front pockets and epaulets (long sleeve in colder weather, short sleeve in warmer weather)
- ♦ Black pants (male) or black A-line skirt (female). There must be no decoration or extra stitching on pants or skirt. Skirt or pants may have no more than three pleats on each side on the front.
- Black socks (male staff and Pathfinders), black ultra sheer stockings (female staff and Pathfinders over 12 years old), black knee-high socks or black ultra sheer stockings for female Pathfinders under 12 years old. There must be no decoration on the socks.
- ♦ The Beret

The Black Beret is the standard headgear for class "A" - full dress uniform of Pathfinders and Master Guides. The beret is worn so that the headband (edge binding) is straight across the forehead, 1in above the eyebrows. The Pathfinder emblem known as the flash is positioned over the left eye and the excess material is draped over to the right ear, extending to at least the top of the ear, and no lower than the middle of the ear. When worn properly, the beret is formed to the shape of the head. TLTs wear a black beret with the TLT emblem in similar fashion.





NECKERCHIEFS:



♦ Neckerchief, Pathfinder

Pathfinder scarf/neckerchief is to be fitted neatly around the neck, held together in front with the appropriate loop device of either metal, plastic or cloth, but nevertheless having the Pathfinder logo affixed and properly positioned; This neckerchief is yellow-gold in color bordered in black with the World Pathfinder emblem as the logo on the back, which is accompanied with the Pathfinder slide. This is to be worn by all inducted Pathfinders and Non-Master Guide Staff.



Neckerchief, Pathfinder TLT

Internal to NEC: Red in color bordered in black with the TLT emblem as the logo on the back, which is accompanied with the TLT slide. This is to be worn by all inducted TLTs. (The NAD Yellow-Gold Neckerchief with red border is the official neckerchief of the TLT Ministry.)

- ♦ Sleeves: Club name crest, Pathfinder triangle patch on the right sleeve and Conference patch, Union patch, Pathfinder World patch on the left sleeve of the uniform shirt;
 - Right: 1/2in from seam/shoulder place the Club Name crest, 1/2in below the crest place the Rank Strip (Staff), 1/2in below the Rank Strip or 1/2in below the crest if not staff, place the Pathfinder patch
 - Left: 1/2in from seam/shoulder place the Conference patch, place the Union patch 1/4in below Conference patch, place the Pathfinder World patch 1/4in below Union patch



- ♦ All Pathfinder patches, except the class patches, must have the black border and must be properly fixed to the uniform.
- Black standard tie with four in hand knot for males and tuxedo tie for females
- ♦ White gloves
- Black Honor sash (if you have at least one honor patch or were invested in any class)
- ♦ Black Pathfinder belt with the correct Pathfinder buckle, holding pants/skirt neatly at the waist.
- ♦ Black, laced up, leather or low rubber soled Oxford style shoes with no decoration or extra stitching; no patent leather/glossy shoes
- ♦ Jewelry should NOT be worn with the exception of a watch, engagement and wedding rings or medical identification chains.

Pathfinder Class "B" Service Dress Uniform

- ♦ The Class "B" Service dress uniform is less formal attire that is appropriate for Worship Services and non-field activities where the Class "A" is out of place.
- One of the authorized Conference, Area, or Club shirts
- ♦ Black Pathfinder belt with correct Pathfinder buckle, holding pants/skirt neatly at the waist.
- Black pants (male) and black A-line skirt (female). There must be no decoration or extra stitching on the pants or skirt. Skirt or pants may have no more than 3 pleats on each side on the front.
- Black socks (male Pathfinders and staff), black stockings (female staff and Pathfinders over 12 years old), black socks or stockings for female Pathfinders under 12. There must be no decoration on the socks.
- Black, laced up, leather or low rubber soled Oxford shoes with no decoration or extra stitching;
 no patent leather/glossy shoes
- Shirts are worn tucked into the skirt or pants of the Class B Service Dress uniform of both males and females.
- ♦ Jewelry should NOT be worn with the exception of a watch, engagement and wedding rings or medical identification chains.

Pathfinder Class "B" Field Uniform

- Whenever Class A uniform is not required, Class B uniform must be worn on all Pathfinder approved and sponsored activities or events. Each club must agree to a Class B Field Uniform standard which must be adhered to by all staff and club members. The club T-shirt must have the Club name and the Pathfinder logo prominently imprinted and displayed somewhere on it. Where instructed, at Area or Conference events, the Area or Conference T-shirt may be substituted for the club T-shirt. Officers are permitted the use of a staff polo style shirt with the appropriate Conference, Area or Club designs.
- In addition to the shirt, the field uniform will consist of black/blue jeans, white tube socks and sneakers.
- Males will wear the shirts of the field uniform tucked into their jeans at all times. Jeans are not to be worn baggy or hanging below the waist.

- Females may wear the shirts of the Field Uniform out of their jeans/pants covering their middles at all times.
- Jewelry should NOT be worn with the exception of a watch, engagement and wedding rings or medical identification chains.

The Field Cap:

- ♦ The black field cap is authorized for use with the Class B uniform.
- ♦ The Field cap must always have an authorized Pathfinder emblem on it. Area and Club designed Field Caps are authorized.

Summer uniform options/accessories

♦ Hat: An optional hat may be worn consisting of fabric suitable for warm weather. It should have the official Pathfinder or Master Guide insignia affixed.






Winter Uniform/ Inclement Weather Uniform Options/Accessories

Pathfinders should be garbed in long sleeve under garments (black) and long sleeve shirts in colder weather; When outdoor activities are warranted, Pathfinders should wear a club agreed to inclement weather outer garment which conveys the values of Pathfinder ministry as does the Class A uniform. Women and girls may wear pants for special teams activities and during outdoor activities in colder weather. Suitably insignia'd hoodies, ponchos and pea coats are permissible.



PATHFINDER UNIFORM SLEEVES



Pathfinder Class Insignia

One chevron is worn representing the highest invested level below the Pathfinder World emblem on the left sleeve. The strip of the highest completed class in worn above the left pocket. The highest advance level insignia is placed above the class strip. The pin of the highest completed class is placed in the center of the left pocket. Chevrons, class pins, class name strips, and advanced class level bars of the remaining lower classes are worn on the sash. Insignia on the sash are to be placed in the following order: from top to bottom is Friend, Companion, Explorer, Ranger, Voyager, Guide. All persons (Master Guide included) should wear only the class insignia in which they have been invested.



Pocket flap locations

There are four designated locations for other pins on the pocket flap. Two on the left side of the button and two on the right side of the button. They are identified as locations A, B, C, & D. Only one pin should be worn in each position at a given time. Normally the "highest" level pin (typically the most recently earned) is worn.

Position A: Baptismal Pin
Position B: PBE Pin or PLA Pin

 $Position\,C: TLT\,Pin, Master\,TLT\,Pin\,or\,PIA\,Pin.$

Position D: TLT Level Pin or the Staff Service Star.



Class Pocket Strip

Centered just above the left pocket of the shirt or blouse is the Pathfinder Class pocket strip for the highest Pathfinder Class in which the individual has been invested. It should be level with the top of the uniform shirt pocket.

Advanced Pathfinder Class Ribbon-Bar

This is worn only by those completing the requirements, on the left side of shirt or blouse just above the Pathfinder Class pocket strip.

Pathfinder Excellence Ribbon/Good Conduct Ribbon-Bar

This is worn on the left side of shirt, or blouse above the pocket. It is above the Pathfinder Class pocket strip or Advanced Pathfinder Class Ribbons.

Captain and Scribe Badges

This badge is to be worn by captain and scribe on the sash, or positioned above the left pocket, on the shirt/blouse.

MASTER GUIDE MINISTRY

Master Guide Class "A" Full Dress Uniform-Adventurers and Pathfinders

- The Class A uniform for a Pathfinder Master Guide is comprised of the green coat and trousers or green A-line skirt made of the Army green (AG) shade 415 material and a short or long sleeved tan uniform shirt.
- The class A uniform for an Adventurer Master Guide is comprised of the blue coat and trousers or A-line skirt (the blue shade for Adventurers is Air Force blue) and a short or long sleeved white Adventurer shirt and patches.
- ♦ The black beret is the standard headgear for Class "A" full dress uniform of Pathfinder Master Guides and navy blue for Adventurer Master Guides. The Master Guide beret has the small Master Guide logo. The emblem known as the flash is positioned over the left eye for Pathfinders and the center for Adventurers. The excess material is draped over the right ear, extending to at least the top of the ear and no lower than the middle of the ear. When worn properly, the beret is formed to the shape of the head.

Neckerchief, Master Guide

The neckerchief is yellow/gold bordered in red with the Master Guide emblem printed on the tip of the triangle. The Master Guide neckerchief is to be worn fitted neatly around the neck, held together in front with the appropriate loop device of either metal, plastic or cloth, but nevertheless having the Master Guide logo affixed and properly positioned. The neckerchief is to be worn only by those invested as Master Guides.

Sleeves:





Right-1/2in from seam/shoulder place Club Name crest, 1/2in below crest place Rank Strip (staff only), 1/2in below Rank Strip or 1/2in below crest if not staff, place Pathfinder/Adventurer patch.




Left-1/2in from seam shoulder place Conference patch, place Union Patch 1/4in below Conference patch, place Pathfinder/Adventurer World Patch 1/4in below Union patch, where applicable place Master Guide Star plus chevrons 1/4in below World Patch. Master Guides having earned only the Master Guide without completing all the Pathfinder/Adventurer Class levels wear the star patch without the chevrons.







White gloves for ceremonies



- Black belt with the correct Master Guide buckle, holding pants/skirt neatly at the waist
- Black leather lace up Oxford style shoes. (no patent leather/glossy or thick soled shoes or loafers) Pathfinder Master Guides wear plain black socks with no decorations (males), ultra sheer skin tone or black ultra sheer stockings (females). Adventurer Master Guides wear plain navy blue socks (males), ultra sheer navy blue stockings (females).
- Master Guides are authorized on occasion to wear the Modified Class " A" Uniform which consists of all elements of the Class "A" except the jacket and gloves.

NOTE: In order to wear the Modified Master Guide Class "A" the authorized shirt must have all required patches, pin(s) and name tag. Cords are optional.



Master Guide Class "B" Service Dress Uniform

- ♦ The Class "B" Service Dress uniform is less formal attire that is appropriate for worship services and non-field activities where the Class "A" is out of place.
- One of the authorized shirts i.e. Conference, Master Guide Program, Area, Club in either T- shirt or Polo style.
- Black Master Guide belt with the Master Guide buckle, holding pants/skirt neatly at the waist
- Black pants (male) or black A-line skirt (female). There must be no decoration or extra stitching on pants or skirt. Skirt or pants may have no more than three pleats on each side on the front.
- ♦ Black socks with no decorations (males), skin tone or black ultra sheer stockings (females)
- ♦ Black, laced up, leather or low rubber soled Oxford style shoes with no decoration or extra stitching; no patent leather/glossy shoes
- Shirts are worn tucked into the skirt or pants of the Class B Service Dress uniform of both males and females.

NOTE: The bottoms of the Master Guide Class "B" service Dress Uniform when so ordered is green for Master Guides in Pathfinder service, blue for Master Guides in Adventurer service, or the generic black when specified.

Master Guide Class "B" Field Uniform

- One of the authorized shirts i.e. Conference, Master Guide program, Area, local Club in either T-shirt or Polo style.
- ♦ Black/blue jeans, white socks
- ♦ Black or white sneakers, field shoes or boots
- Males will wear the shirts of the Field Uniform tucked into their jeans at all times. Jeans are not to be worn baggy or hanging below the waist.
- Females will wear shirts of the Field Uniform out of their jeans/pants covering their middles at all times.

The Field Cap:

- ♦ The black Field Cap is authorized for use with the Class "B" uniform.
- ♦ The Field Cap must always have an authorized Master Guide emblem on it. Area and Club designed Field Caps are authorized.

Master Guide Class "A" Ministry Uniform

When operating with field ministries (Pathfinder or Adventurer), Master Guides may wear the Master Guide uniform modified in the color of that ministry in the same specifications as the Standard Green Master Guide Uniform.


MASTER GUIDE UNIFORM DIAGRAMS



ADDITIONAL UNIFORM STANDARDS

- All Executive officers and Area Coordinators wear the Northeastern crest in lieu of the club name on her/his right sleeve.
- ♦ The ministry requires all of its members to maintain a high standard of dress and personal appearance. Pride in each member's personal appearance and uniform wear greatly strengthens the esprit de corps essential to an effective program.
- ♦ The uniform must be kept clean, neat, correct in design and specification, properly fitted, pressed and in good condition.
- The uniform must be worn properly at all times or not worn at all.
- Extra make up, colored nail polish, nail decorations and nail extensions are strictly prohibited. Nails must be neatly clipped and clean.
- ♦ Jewelry should NOT be worn with the exception of a watch, engagement and wedding rings or medical identification chains.
- ♦ The use of the white shirt and black pants/skirt combination is NOT a Pathfinder or Adventurer uniform.
- ♦ FUNERAL NOTE: When a member of the Pathfinder/Adventurer Master Guide Ministry is in attendance or serving at a funeral/ memorial service, it is it is customary NOT to wear the sash.

SPECIAL TEAMS:

Adventurers: The uniform for special team members when serving in that capacity is TBD

Pathfinders:

Conference: The uniform for special team members when serving in that capacity is Off-White beret, white ascot and white single braid cord. The sash is not to be worn with the special team uniform.

Area – The uniform for special team members when serving in that capacity is AREA COLOR BERET, MATCHING ASCOT AND SINGLE BRAID CHORD. The sash is not to be worn with the special team uniform area color.

Club – The uniform for special team members when serving in that capacity is CLUB COLOR BERET, MATCHING ASCOT AND SINGLE BRAID CHORD. The sash is not to be worn with the special team uniform club color.

Master Guides:

The uniform for special team members when serving in that capacity is shirt or jacket with all insignias; GOLD ASCOT; GOLD MASTER GUIDE LOGO'D BERET; MASTER GUIDE UNIFORM bottom, SOCKS, STOCKINGS, SHOES, ETC; The sash is not to be worn with the special team uniform.
