

## Dogs Award

### Kahoot! DogVentures: A Pawsome Virtual Lesson for Adventurers!

**Goal:** Earn the Dogs Adventurer Award through a fun and interactive Kahoot-powered virtual lesson filled with dog appreciation, knowledge, and creative activities!

#### Requirements for the Dogs Award:

1. Give the scientific name of the dog family.
2. Name five distinctive characteristics of the dog family.
3. Identify from pictures or personal observation five wild members of the dog family.
4. Identify from pictures or personal observation 25 different breeds of dogs.
5. Name five contributions the dog family has made to man.
6. Give the name of the smallest and largest breed of dog.
7. Write or describe orally the value to man of the following dogs:
  - a. Seeing-eye
  - b. Saint Bernard
  - c. Shepherd
  - d. Collie
  - e. Eskimo
8. Write or tell what special contribution dogs have made to man in wartime.
9. Identify from pictures or personal observation five dogs that are classed as "toy" dogs.
10. What is the only dog that has a wholly blue or black tongue?
11. Which is the fastest-running dog?
12. Which member of the "toy" dogs has become the most popular?
13. What dog has been especially helpful in tracking criminals?
14. Write or tell a dog story.

#### Kahoot Quiz:

- Theme: Dogs, their importance, and caring for them.
- Questions: A mix of multiple choice, true/false, and picture-based questions covering concepts like:
  - The meanings of Matthew 15:26 and Luke 16:21 about helping others.
  - The meaning of "A dog is man's best friend".
  - Real-life stories of dogs helping people (prepared beforehand).
  - Dog care tips (feeding, grooming, exercise).
  - Different types of dog sounds and their meanings.
  - Images of dog breeds and identifying them.

#### Bonus rounds:

- Dog Sound Relay Race: Play audio clips of different dog sounds, and teams name the sounds fastest.
- Guess the Dog Breed: Show pictures of dog breeds and let teams guess who's who.

#### Post-Kahoot Activities:

- Crafting Corner: Announce the dog-themed craft for the day (e.g., paper bag puppets, paw print paintings). Share photos of everyone's finished creations through Zoom!
- Doggie Games Galore: Organize online group games like:

- "Doggie, Doggie, Where's your Bone?": A virtual hide-and-seek with a hidden "bone" picture.
- "Woof Woof Match Up": A memory game with dog-related picture pairs.
- "Tails of Teamwork": Collaborative storytelling game where each player adds a sentence to a dog-themed story.

### **Engagement and Wrap-up:**

- Use fun avatars, sound effects, and animated backgrounds to keep the Kahoot quiz engaging.
- Encourage participation with positive reinforcement and virtual high-fives.
- Discuss the importance of treating animals with kindness and respecting their needs.

- Adapt the difficulty of the Kahoot questions and activities based on the children's age and knowledge level.
- Encourage parents to participate and assist with the craft and game activities.
